This Sunday we begin our experiments with re-opening St John’s for public worship. There will be an **8am Morning Prayer on August 16th and a 4pm Evening Service on August 23rd**. Because of social distancing, numbers will be restricted to about 30 people in the pews. Face masks **must** be worn, unless there is a medical reason. **The 10am Zoom Service will continue for some time yet because of the Covid restrictions.** The Standing Committee are exploring the possibility of a

Eucharistic Service. Church regulations prevent this happening ‘on zoom’. A special Sunday in September will be made available when several opportunities to receive Communion in Church will be offered.
