

We are staying Covid secure in 2020

We are pleased to be able to welcome people back into our church.

The church has now been able to reopen with measures in place to ensure that visitors feel and remain safe when visiting the church. Details of when the church is open can be found in the news and notices section of the website.

We have carried out Covid-19 risk assessments on all church buildings which are open to the public.

We have cleaning, handwashing and hygiene procedures in place in line with government guidelines. Hand sanitisers have been provided within church buildings.

We have posters around the buildings to remind people to keep to the 2 metre distance rule and to follow the guidance on hand sanitisation and the wearing of masks. There is a one way system within the church for private prayer, with different entry and exit doors for private prayer and for all services.

Face masks or visors are to be worn at all times in church.

The Parish Room and Centenary Room have also been able to open for groups to use by prior arrangement, and a full covid risk assessment has been carried out on both and the results of those shared with those using the rooms.

We have track and trace notices in place and, for those who have a smart phone and the NHS Covid app, ask people to scan the NHS QR code. Attendees also provide their contact details which are retained for 21 days.
